

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Metropolitan Sewer Sub-District Yearly Emergency and Maintenance Contract 2012

The Metropolitan Sewer Sub-District (herein called the "Owner") will receive bids until 2:00 P.M. (local time) on February 27, 2012, at the Metropolitan Sewer Sub-District's Administrative Building, 120 Augusta Arbor Way, Greenville, South Carolina for the Yearly Emergency and Maintenance Contract for Metropolitan Sewer Sub-District.

This project consists of providing construction support services for the District during a one-year period beginning May 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013. The Contract may be extended up to two additional years at the Owner's discretion and the Contractor's concurrence. The Contract is divided into 4 parts as follows:

- Emergency Repairs – Work shall consist of repairs necessary to maintain sanitary sewer flows in an emergency situation. Work may include point repairs, sewer line replacement, sewer service tee and lateral replacement, traffic control, and by-pass pumping.
- Manhole Adjustments – Work shall consist of the raising or lowering of existing manholes.
- Sewer Rehabilitation Projects – Work shall consist of the repair and rehabilitation of portions of existing sewer in which failure is imminent. Work may include point repairs, full segment replacement, manhole replacement, sewer service tee and lateral replacement, traffic control, and by-pass pumping.
- Site and Pavement Restoration – Work shall consist of permanent site and pavement restoration, and miscellaneous items associated with emergencies and rehabilitation work. Work may include the restoration of existing roads, parking lots, driveways, lawns, and landscaping; erosion control measures; and selective tree removal.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on February 9, 2012 at 10:00 A.M. to address any contractor questions. The meeting will be held at the Metropolitan Sewer Sub-District's Administrative Building, 120 Augusta Arbor Way, Greenville, South Carolina.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375, which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin.

Where applicable Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours and minority-owned businesses.

Contract Documents may be examined at the offices of the Owner and the Engineer; at the Associated General Contractors Plan rooms in COLUMBIA, SC, and CHARLOTTE, NC; and at the offices of LDI Reprinting Centers located at 1200 Woodruff Road, Suite G5, GREENVILLE, SC 29607.

Street address must be provided to ensure prompt delivery.

Attention of Bidders is directed to applicable employment laws and regulations and to minimum wage and hour laws.

Each Bidder must be qualified under the provisions of the South Carolina Contractor's Licensing Law, 1976 Code, Section 40-11-10, et seq.

The Owner reserves the right to reject all bids or an individual bid, and to waive any informalities and technicalities in the bid. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof.
