Sealed bids for the project entitled, "CHESTNUT NEIGHBORHOOD SANITARY SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT", will be received by the City of Shelby on Monday, March 21, 2011 at 2:00 pm at the City of Shelby Utilities Operations Center at 824 West Grover Street, Shelby, NC 28150, and then at said location publicly opened and read aloud.

**The work will consist of constructing complete in place the rehabilitation of approximately 11,500LF of existing 6-, to 15-inch sewers and 67 manholes via open-cut replacement, cured-in-place pipe lining and manhole cementitious lining. This work includes approximately 1,300 LF of new replacement 20-inch DIP in the Palmer Park area.**

There will be a refundable deposit of \$100 for each set of documents thus obtained.

**A mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Monday, March 14, 2011 at 2:00 pm at the City of Shelby Utilities Operation Center.**

Minority and female owned contractors are encouraged to bid. The low bidder shall identify the minority business participation it will use on the project as applicable prior to project award. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

This is a federally funded project and contractor will have to comply with Davis Bacon, Section 3, E.O. 11246, Non Discrimination, Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act Provisions etc. as are applicable to a project of this nature.

Bids may be held by the City of Shelby for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing bids and investigating qualifications of bidders. The City also reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive informalities or technicalities as it may deem to be in its best interest.

A bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the contract sum must be submitted with each bid. The bid security will be in the form of cash, a cashier's check or a certified check from a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation made payable to the order of the City of Shelby. In lieu of making a cash deposit, the bidder may submit a bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed in North Carolina to execute such bonds.

All bids will be placed in a sealed envelope having the Bidder's name, address, North Carolina General Contractor's License Number, and the statement **"BID FOR CHESTNUT NEIGHBORHOOD SANITARY SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT, DO NOT OPEN UNTIL MARCH 21, 2011 AT 2:00 PM"**.
